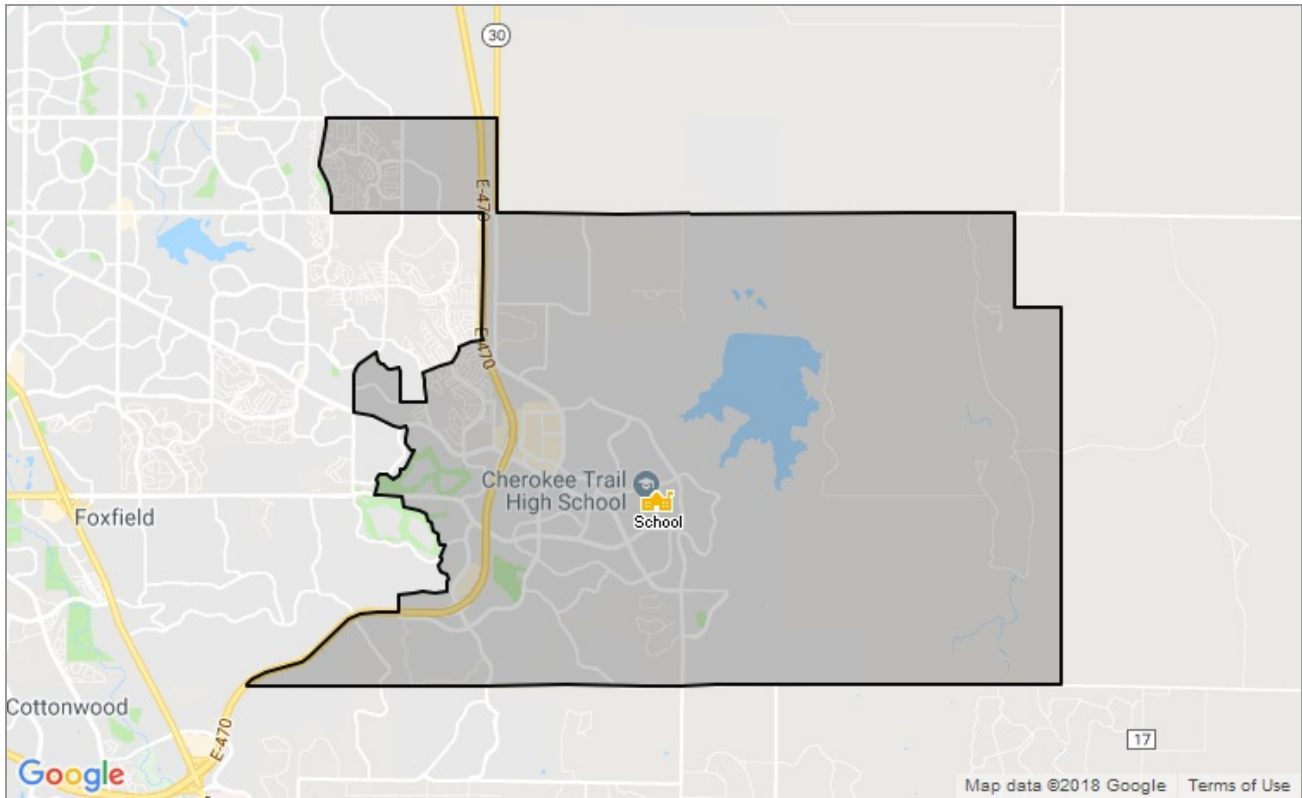

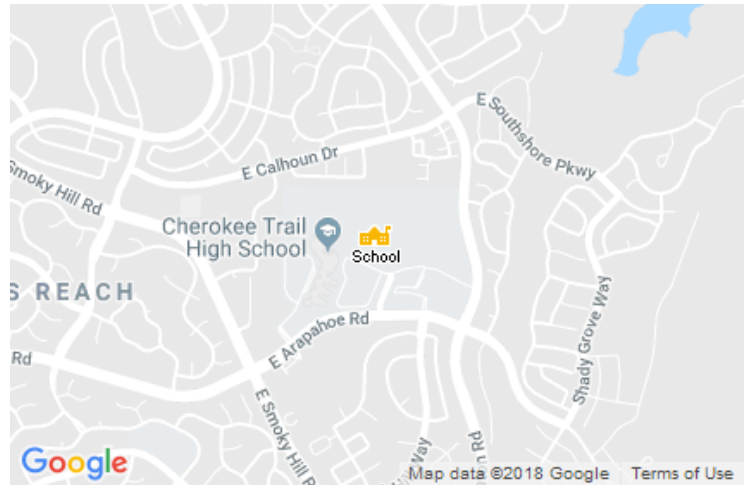

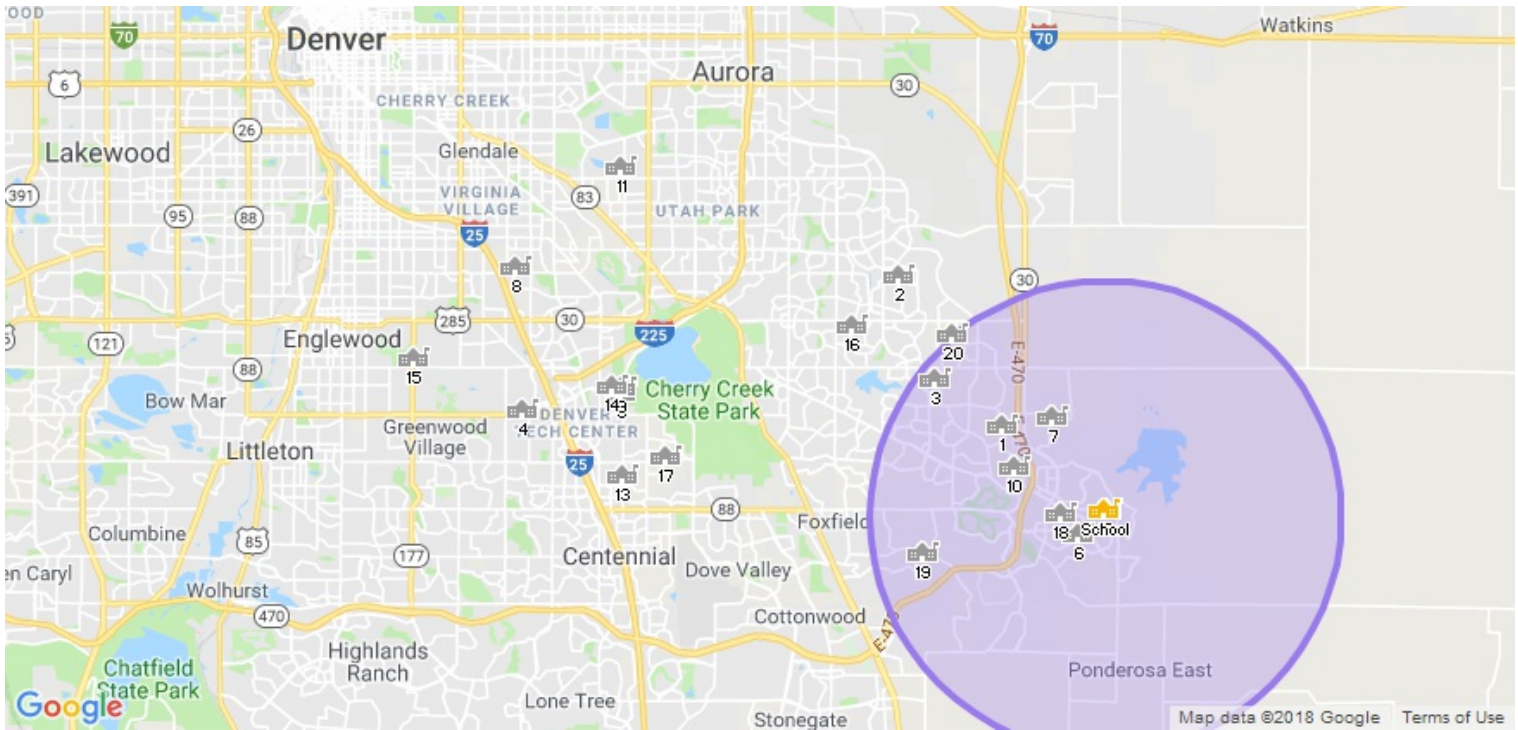

The school has over 50 clubs. Students can even create more clubs if they acquire enough members and find a teacher to sponsor. The quality of the club depends on two things: whether or not there is a really involved club leader, or if there is a really involved sponsor. Clubs with good members and good sponsors thrive, and clubs that don't have those things don't do as well. The school doesn't really fund clubs; athletics take priority and they get all the funding. For clubs to get funds, they have to do fundraising. The more fundraising the club does, the more money it gets. Clubs like to involve communities outside of school, and love to do field trips if there is money. French club and Spanish club have organized a field trip to France and Spain. Hip-hop club likes to perform for neighboring Elementary schools. Funded clubs or organizations are usually honor societies. They usually require a fee to join and have requirements such as a certain GPA. Sports are generously funded. They have a lot of support from students, teachers, and parents. There are also opportunities for extracurricular activities in performing arts. In fact, the teacher encourages the students to participate in afterschool programs. They give us opportunities to challenge ourselves and audition for state band or honor band. Administration supports the students and try to get them involved. They even created a hype squad! Though there are many opportunities to participate, it is sometimes frustrating that people don't get involved enough.
